Important Information

This festival is for films that have been produced by children aged up to 12 years. The entire film must be conceived and produced by a child or children with minimal adult input. However, the entry forms must be checked and signed by an adult. There is no fee to submit a film.

Criteria for screening is:

- The film should be child-driven
- Film content should be original

Criteria for Non-acceptance includes:

- Excessive or gratuitous violence, nudity or profanity
- Content that advocates and supports racial, cultural, religious and/or gender bias

Films may be disqualified for technical or procedural reasons including:

- Films submitted on formats other than stated on the entry form
- Films that are purely educational or instructional in nature
- Films that are intended primarily for an adult audience
- Films that are not child produced

Instructions

- Please type or print clearly. If we receive one entry form and one DVD containing multiple productions, only the first production will be viewed and considered.
- Each film submitted must be on a separate DVD
